
Somatosensory Mechanisms

Sensation

- · All sensations involve:
 - Location where the sensation was felt.
 - Character what the sensation was
 - Kinaesthesia sense of movement.
 - Proprioception relation to other body parts
- Sensations depend on neurons:
 - Group I and group II neurons = large-diameter, myelinated afferent fibres associated with tactile, kinaesthetic and proprioceptive sensations
 - Group III and group IV neurons = small-diameter, unmyelinated afferent fibres associated with thermal and pain sensations



Primary Afferent Fibres - "Sensory Detectors"

- Primary afferent fibres are primarily bipolar (the have two axonal processes)
 - 1st process = primary afferent terminal/receptor complex
 - 2 processes are separated by a cell body/soma (in the dorsal root ganglion)
 - 2nd process = central dendrites = termination point within the CNS
- Somatic sensations are those that are elicited by stimulation of body tissues other than those specialised for sight, balance, hearing and taste
